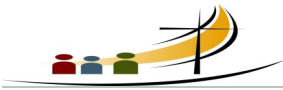
**Apply for the Student of the Month Program!**

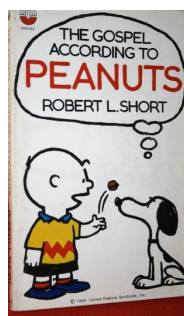

The Conversion Experience

As most of you know, we were able to convert a number of videotapes to DVD's which had relevance to the St. Leonard Chapel, the Franciscan Seminary, liturgical dance, community parties, and many Masses, etc. In fact, over 1300 copies of the first 32 conversions to DVD's were made available after Mass in late June and early July 2014. Since then, another seven DVD's have been found and made.

These DVD's are available upon request. Therefore, beginning **August 10** through **August 31**, all 39 DVD's will be described on a list at both entrances to the chapel.

- How many DVD's requested
- Print name and phone number on the request form
- Return to the ledge at entry to the chapel

Three things I ask:

1-If you previously picked up DVD #2, "*The Mass Celebrating the 50th Anniversary of the Chapel*" and discovered that it was not complete, **THROW IT AWAY**. Re-order DVD #2 on your request form (please do not return DVD 2).

2-Let me know if you have other DVD's that are not complete. Please indicate the number on the form.

3-Suggestions? Please let me know how we might use the DVD's to provide enlightenment to other people about the experiences that we have had through the many priests, people, and our community.

Also, some people have asked how much the DVD's cost. In the manner in which the Franciscans taught us, you can make any contribution you want. Collections will benefit the Faith Community and can be placed in the offering basket.

During the past few months I have been privileged to do the conversion of videotapes to DVD's for the Faith Community. You have been very appreciative taking and reliving some of our community history as I have.

However, like so many other things people are recognized for what they do and that is as it should be, BUT there are many others who have contributed recently and in the past 40 year that we don't know about.

Fortunately, Dave Pleva has helped me discover people in our community that we don't see in the DVD's, but they play a very important part in the community. They are the camera operators!
