Parents' Corner June 2013

School is out, and the long days of summer are upon us. How can you make faith an important part of your children's summer? Here are five ways:

1. Make Mass a priority. Traveling? No problem! Research Catholic churches in your vacation spot (see mass-times.org), and make exploring other churches an adventure!
2. Register for Vacation Bible School! This year's VBS is western-inspired, so kick up your boots and come learn about Jesus! St. Leonard's VBS is June 23rd-27th from 6-8:30PM. Registration details are online at <http://stleonardfaithcommunity.org/vacation-bible-school>. **Registration is requested by June 16th.**
3. Start a family faith night. Pray together outside under the stars, or read and discuss the Bible together. Not sure if you can lead a Bible study on your own? Look online or browse a Christian bookstore for Catholic Bible study resources.
4. Teach your children about poverty and homelessness with a *shantytown project*. Build a shantytown out of cardboard and duct tape. Cook a simple meal over a campfire, and sleep in the makeshift cardboard structures. Turn it into a fundraising project by inviting neighbors and collecting canned goods.
5. Transform regular summer activities into teaching opportunities. Planning on going to the pool? Read and discuss Jesus walking on water (Matthew 14:22-33). Camping or hiking? Read the creation stories (Genesis 1:1-2:3 and 2:4-25) as you marvel at the beauty of God's creation.

Thoughts on Today's Readings Today's Gospel describes the miraculous feeding of more than 5,000 people. We see in this story the miracle of the Eucharist. Jesus continues to feed the Communion procession lines with his own body and blood.

The most challenging line in the Gospel is "Give them some food yourselves." Our world population is at 7 billion, and more than 100 babies come into this world each minute. In that same minute, three die of starvation. Most people who die of starvation are children, their little eyes closing at a rate of 180 per hour, 4,320 per day. It adds up to more than 1.5 million deaths per year. Again, across the centuries, Jesus says to us, "Give them some food yourselves."
